Short description:

Seascape Belgium seeks to recruit an experienced, creative and motivated Senior Communication Officer with experience in content development and project management to strengthen its professional and dynamic team.

The post holder will be involved in implementing Seascape Belgium's communication, dissemination and outreach tasks in a range of collaborative European marine and coastal projects. As appropriate, the incumbent will also provide support to other relevant projects and initiatives, particularly in relation to the development and delivery of communication products. The work will also involve interactions with other relevant developments and initiatives in Europe and globally (e.g. in support of the UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development).

Seascape's project portfolio spans a broad range of thematic areas including but not limited to marine biology and biodiversity, ocean observing and data collection, ocean governance, marine research infrastructure services, marine data management, maritime spatial planning, marine genetic resources management, ocean literacy and the pursuit of a sustainable, circular blue economy. Role & Responsibilities:

The main responsibilities and tasks of this position will include the following:

- Project management, implementation and delivery of Seascape Belgium's communication activities
 in a selection of projects, ensuring the quality and timely delivery of contractual obligations and
 project outputs;
- Leading content planning, production and delivery for assigned projects across different channels, with a special focus on ensuring content and visual design quality and attractiveness, including social media content.
- Overseeing and contributing to the development and dissemination of targeted communication materials (e.g. brochures, infographics, press releases, leaflets, newsletters, etc.); developing multimedia products (e.g. video, tutorials, ...);
- Quality control of all communication products and activities of selected projects;
- Contributing to the delivery of attractive and engaging policy briefs and strategic roadmaps;
- Contributing to event organisation, stakeholder engagement and facilitation (workshops, meetings, conferences, ...).



Profile and competences required:

The successful candidate is expected to have the following qualifications and competences:

- Graduate qualification in a relevant discipline, preferably with a background in scientific/environmental communication, journalism and/or public relations— or alternatively, a background in marine or environmental science with demonstrable experience in science communication and content management and development;
- At least 8 years of experience developing and delivering targeted communication outputs against project-based objectives for a relevant organisation;
- Experience in communicating technical and scientific information in an engaging way to different target audiences across a range of media;
- Demonstrable experience in developing technically accurate and engaging content without supervision;
- Experience in managing communications channels, including but not limited to digital, social media, print, and events, matching channels with specific audiences and expected outcomes;
- Experience with organising events from planning to execution phase;
- Good working knowledge of MS Office packages and relevant online data and information management systems (including Content Management Systems for websites);
- Excellent standard of spoken and written English. Knowledge of other European languages would be an advantage;
- Ability to report progress and issues in an effective manner and ability to draft concise and clear documents and reports without supervision;
- Experience working with multidisciplinary teams, with strong interpersonal and communication skills with ability to work transparently while applying a team-oriented work ethic. Ability to build successful and productive relationships with stakeholders, user groups and other project team members;
- Excellent organisational skills with capacity to multitask, to deliver on allocated tasks and to meet deadlines in pressurised situations;
- Ability and willingness to work at strategic, tactical and operational levels, with a strong can-do attitude to handle the diverse requirements of this role.
- Versatility and flexibility to adapt to changing requirements: independent worker, solution-focused creative thinker and problem solver.

Additional expertise and qualities which would be beneficial:

- Awareness and understanding of the marine science and policy landscape in Europe and globally, as well as the main stakeholders operating in this domain;
- Experience in project management in a professional setting, with a qualification in project management being an advantage;
- Knowledge of Adobe Creative suite programmes is not essential, but a plus;
- Knowledge of website content management systems (Drupal, Wordpress) is a plus;
- Experience in presenting at international project meetings and workshops as well as in related stakeholder fora;
